TPG Kicks into Gear with Consumer Plans Changes

Sydney, 19 July 2011 – TPG has today made significant improvements in their Standalone ADSL2+ and ADSL2+ with Home Phone Bundle plans to stay ahead of competitors in the Australian broadband market.

TPG's Standalone ADSL2+ plans have been enhanced with major increases in their monthly usage quota. For example, the quota on the popular \$49.99 ADSL2+ plan has gone up from 200GB (anytime) to 500GB (250GB peak + 250GB off-peak).
